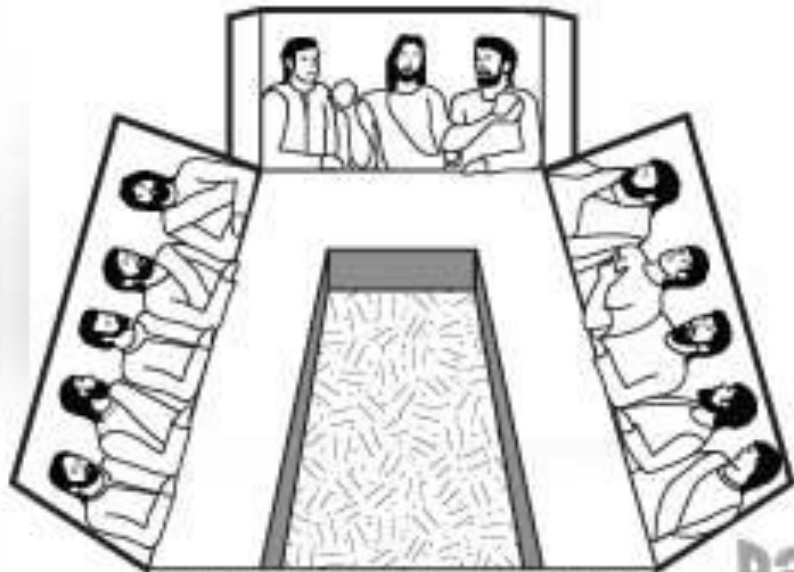

# Materials

- Cereal Box
- Pencil
- Markers/Crayons/Paints
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Cellotape
- Glue/double sided sticky tape

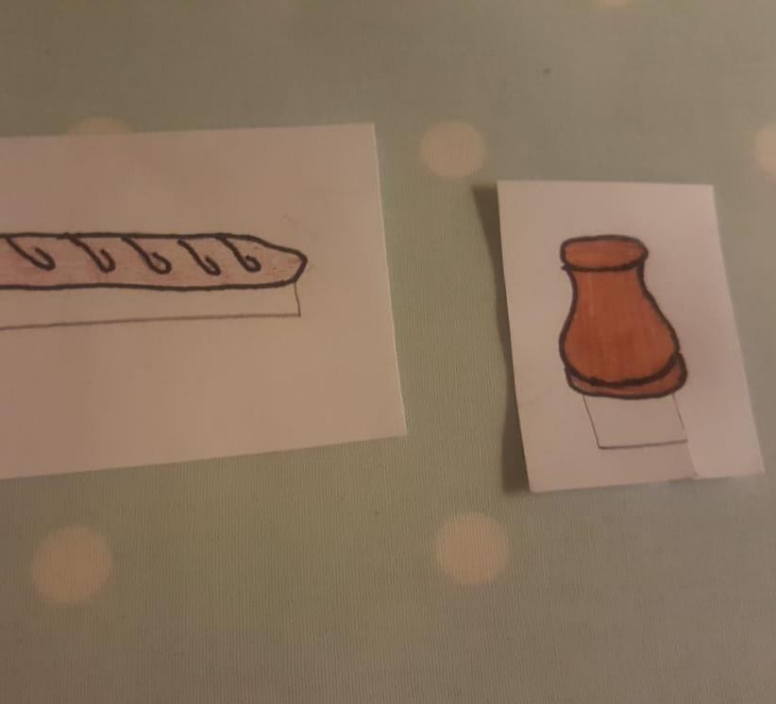

To make the table cut out a large rectangle of paper. Colour a small rectangle orange and the rest brown.



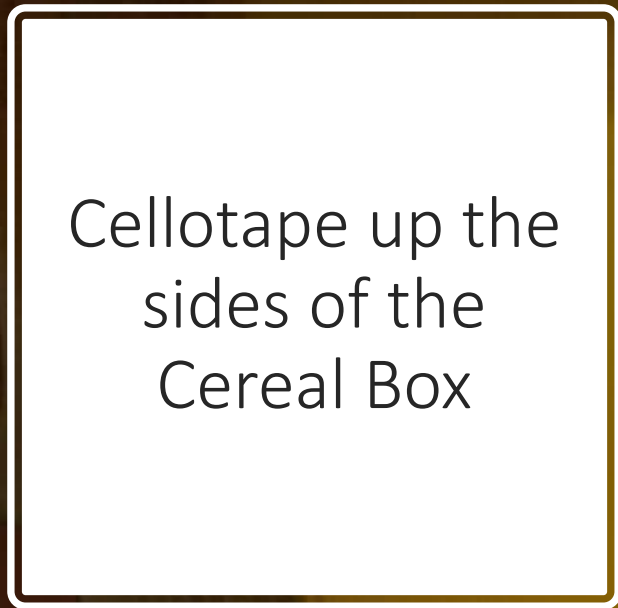


Stick the Jesus, the
